Action Taken Report

1) Title of the Activity: One Day Workshop on Mind Mapping Technique For Vocabulary Development

2) Date of the Activity: 17/12/2024 Time : 12.10 pm

3) Objectives/Purpose

1) To help participants use mind mapping as a tool to visually organize and connect new vocabulary words, making it easier to remember and recall them in various contexts.

2) To train participants in creating associations between words and concepts, enhancing their ability to understand word meanings, synonyms, antonyms, and related terms, which strengthens word usage?

3) To foster active engagement with new vocabulary by using mind mapping to promote critical thinking, creativity, and personal connections with the words, thereby enhancing language comprehension and application.

4) To demonstrate how mind maps can be used to expand vocabulary depth and breadth, helping learners incorporate new words naturally into their speech and writing, ultimately improving overall language fluency.

4) Organising Department : Department of English

5) Participants : One Hundred Sixty students participated in the workshop. There were 98 girls and 62 boys among the participants. The worksheet and feedback were submitted by 133 students.

6) Event or Activity Description

There were one hundred sixty students from undergraduate classes as participants in the workshop. The students were notified four days earlier by circulating brochure on whats app group of all the undergraduate classes.

The workshop was divided into two halves. The first half the inauguration of the workshop was organized. Principal Dr. M. T. Nikam was the chairperson of the workshop while Dr. V. U. Pochhi, the IQAC Coordinator was the inaugurator. Dr. Satish More from SPM College was present as the resource person. After the completion of all the formalities of the inaugural ceremony, the actual working of the workshop began.


In the second half of the workshop the resource person Dr. Satish More introduced the students the basics of Mind Mapping Technique and how it can be implemented for vocabulary development. Two students viz. *Ritesh Bharat Nade* and *Harshal Sudhir Dhanlobhe* gave PPT presentation on the topic. The resource person, the Principal and the IQAC Coordinator appreciated the students endeavour. Then Handouts containing the explanation and examples of Mind Mapping Technique and how it can be implemented for vocabulary development, were distributed among the students. Dr. S. I. Jukkalkar, the HoD explained the examples in detail. The doubts of the students were also addressed. Then the students were given working sheets. Mr. Sanket Rindhe and Miss Nita Ubhe helped the students to write responses in the sheets. Half an hour was given to the students. It was found that students were enjoying the activity and they were discussing with each other. The response sheets were collected. Some students gave very good feedback orally. At the end of the workshop participants were asked to fill the feedback form. In the end of the workshop the resource person asked the students to practice this technique for vocabulary development.

Analysis of the Collected Data in the form of Working Sheets

There were five questions in working sheet each was allotted 10 Marks. The instruction was to write at least 20 words related to the question. In the last question the students were asked to draw a Mind Map for the central word e-Commerce. Students were given 30 minutes to write the answer.

After collecting the Worksheets the data was analysed. The analysis is as follows:

The above analysis shows that 28 students answered the questions in working sheet very appropriately and scored marks in the range of 40-50. Ninety-five students scored more than 50% of marks. Only ten students scored less than fifty per cent.

The study proves that Mind Mapping Technique is very useful technique for vocabulary development. The improved vocabulary helps to develop effective communication skill. Students also learnt to brainstorm to find new linked words related to the central word.

7) Outcome/Achievements

- 1) Participants used mind mapping as a tool to visually organize and connect new vocabulary words, making it easier to remember and recall them while working on response sheets.
- 2) Participants became successful in creating associations between words and concepts, enhancing their ability to understand word meanings, synonyms, antonyms, and related terms as the analysis of response sheets shows.
- 3) Participants actively engaged in the activity.

4) Participants learnt how mind maps can be used to expand vocabulary depth and breadth, helping learners incorporate new words naturally into their speech and writing, ultimately improving overall language fluency.

8) Feedback Analysis (Qualitative Analysis)

Out of One Hundred Sixty participants 126 students submitted the feedback. Most of the students have shown their satisfaction on overall organization of the workshop. The important take away of the workshop for many students was the work sheet. Many students wished to participate in such workshop in future also. Students also suggested to incorporate language games in the worksheet in the future workshops.
















