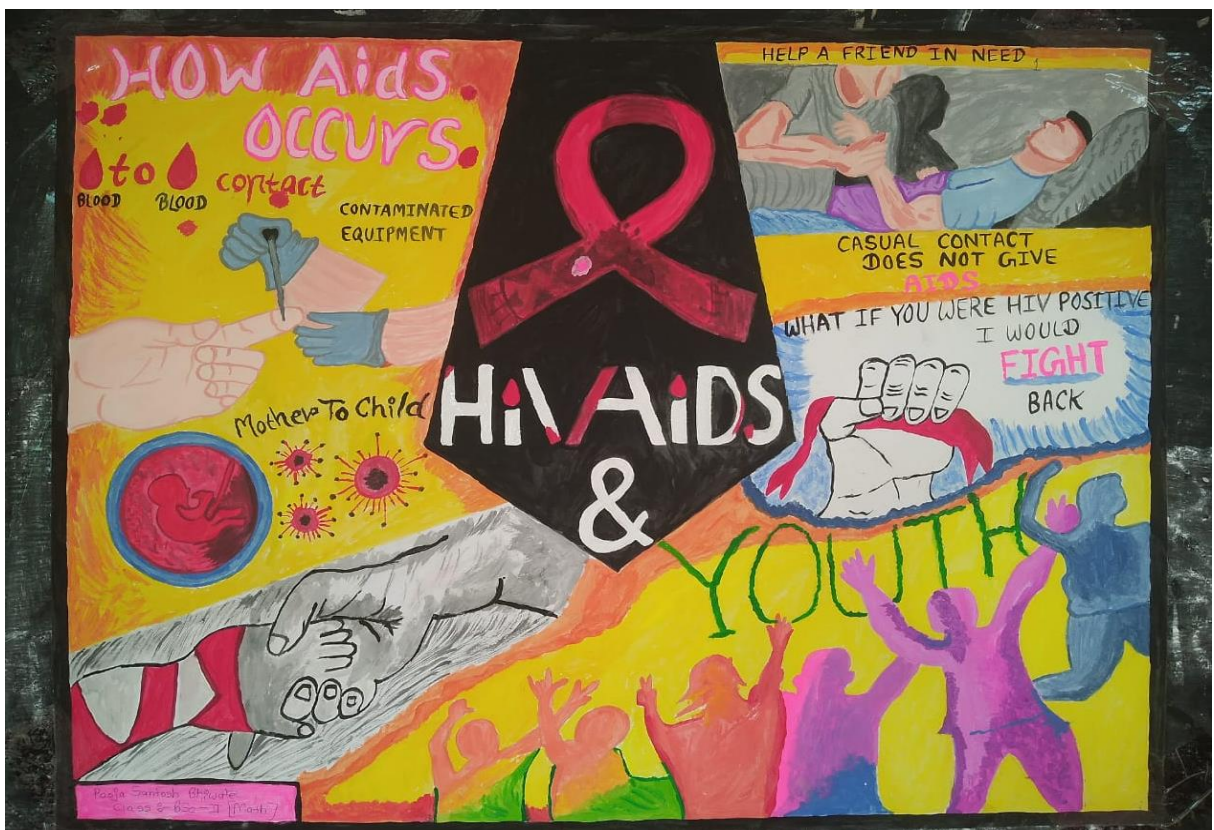

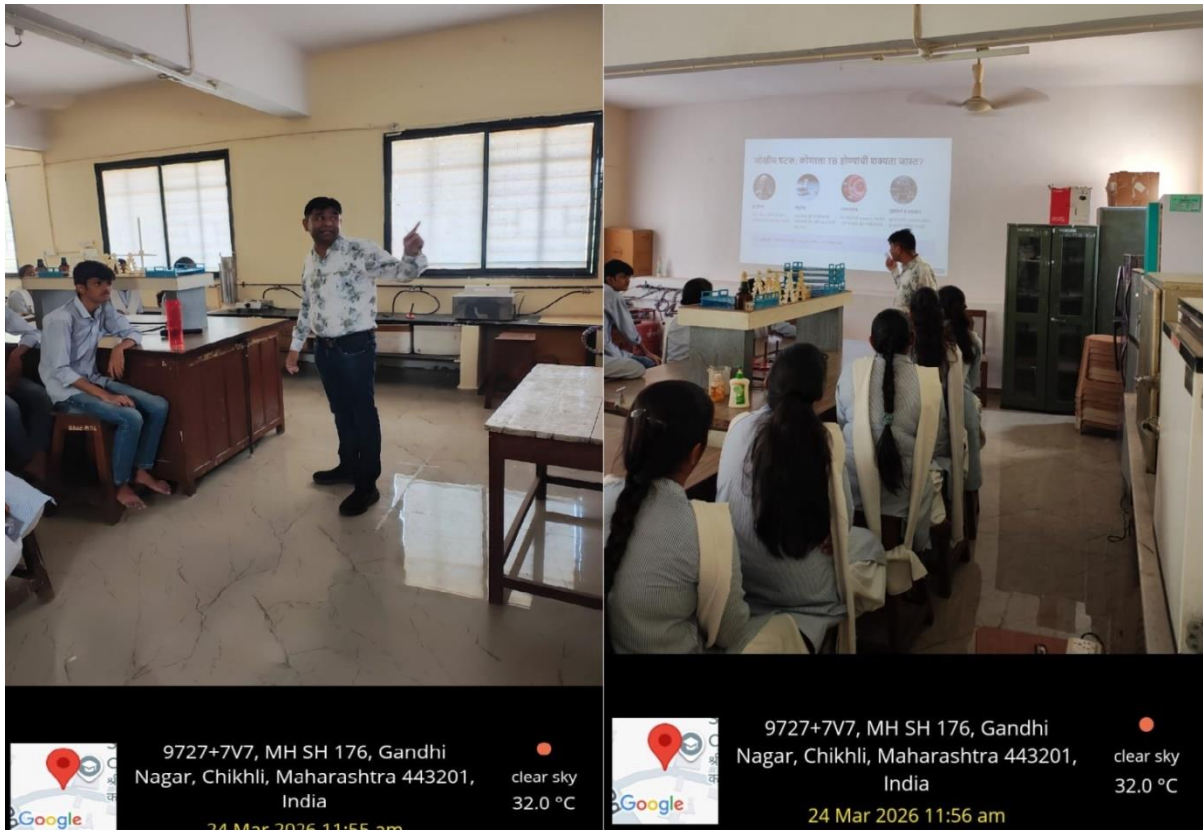


B) Organization of Tuberculosis awareness programme:
