History and Heritage

Over the years, the college has established a commendable tradition of initiative and innovation, growing into an institution of significant stature in the educational landscape. Its diverse academic activities, imbued with a strong value system, focus on balancing knowledge acquisition with skill development. The institution has successfully instilled confidence in society regarding the quality of education it imparts.

The college was established in **1967** to cater to the ever-growing educational needs of society under the banner of **Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati**. Visionary leaders such as **Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh** and **Dalitmitra Pandharinath Patil** played a pivotal role in its foundation. Eminent personalities including **Adv. R. D. Bhonde 'Sarkar'** and **Dalitmitra Santoshrao Patil**, along with other socio-political leaders, extended significant support in establishing this institution. The local farming community also contributed generously to this noble endeavor.

The students of this institution, through exemplary discipline and active participation in academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities, along with the dedicated support of their teachers, have contributed immensely to building the institution's reputation in academic and other fields.

The institution has consistently followed a policy of self-renewal and adaptation to changing educational scenarios. It began with the introduction of the **Science faculty at the undergraduate level in 1967**, followed by the **Humanities (Arts) faculty in 1971**, and **Commerce & Management in 1989**. Postgraduate programs were introduced with **M. Com. in 2009** and **PG programs in Science and Arts in 2010**. An **English-medium UG Commerce program** was launched in 2011. Research programs such as **M.Phil. and Ph.D.** in Science, Arts, and Commerce have also been initiated. The **YCMOU Study Centre** was established in 2012.

The college has achieved several accolades and recognitions for its academic excellence, research innovation, and social outreach. Some of the notable achievements are:

Additionally, soft skill development courses are conducted to ensure the holistic development of students.

With a continuous vision for growth, the institution has been further strengthened under the leadership of **Hon'ble Shri Harshvardhan P. Deshmukh** and other executive members of the society. 5.0 Rules and Regulations:

1. Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
2. The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board of the college.
3. The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case the student does not deposit the fees by that date, his/her admission will be treated as cancelled.
4. Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees as per university rules.
5. No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
6. **All new entrants will have to enrol themselves in the university. A prescribed form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time or on the date prescribed by the university. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.**
7. Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an indisciplined manner will be expelled from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents and/or guardians have read and concurred with these rules.
8. **Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of disobedience, improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks, especially at girl students, is a punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.**
9. Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
10. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom. Students, therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.
11. No student shall send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval of the Principal of college, nor shall he/she approach the President L.M.C. Members except through the college he/she approach the President or the Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
12. The students should not roam in corridors, or play during working hours or free classes. Instead, they should utilize the library and reading room facilities.

Spitting, littering, Chewing paan/gutka or other intoxicants and smoking is strictly prohibited in college premises. Any infringers will be dealt with severely in accordance with prevailing laws.
- No meetings or programmes should be organized in the college campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
- UG students will have to go for medical check-up by the college appointed medical officer and will have to appear for physical efficiency test.
- Notice will be pasted /pinned on the Notice Board and the students themselves should take note of them. Notice will not be circulated in the class-rooms.
- If the student needs information other than given in the prospectus, he should contact the concerned persons in the college office.
- Students are expected not to walk about or make noise in veranda, corridors or lawns when classes are in progress.
- Principal may impose the following punishments in the interest of the students and the institution: fines, cancellation of attendance, withholding of certificates, suspension, expulsion or rustication.
- Students are expected to have regard and consideration for each other and respect for the members of the staff.
- The decisions of the college authority regarding extracurricular activities will be final and binding to each student.
- The students should carefully handle the college books, laboratory equipment, lights, fans etc. They should not, in any way cause damage to the college property. In such case he/she will be punished/ penalized.
- Without permission from the college authority, students/staff members must not provide any information related to the college to the media or any other person/office, etc.
- Students are eligible to receive ST Bus/Train concessions, but they have to furnish the correct information. Misuse of this concession is a punishable offence.
- Attendance at the Flag Hoisting Ceremony on Independence Day (15th, August) Republic Day (26th January and Maharashtra Day (1st May) is compulsory.
- Laboratory Aprons shall be worn by the students during practical classes.
- Students should not organize their own picnics, excursion trips etc. Without prior permission to the Principal.
- Political movements and violent demonstrations are strictly forbidden on the college campus.



Instruction for Parents:

- The parents should read the rules about students' attendance, fees, code of conduct & discipline carefully.
- Parents should be well aware of their ward's attendance and progress, for which they are requested to meet the concerned teacher or Principal 2-3 times a year.
- Parents are requested to remain present in the programs like 'Parents' Meet and other programs.

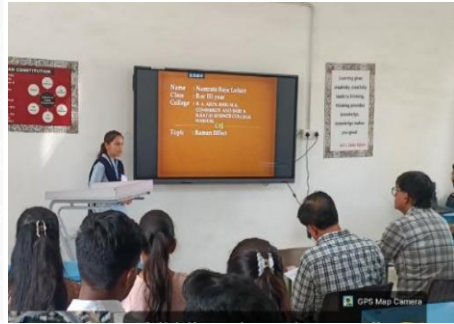
