They include retail nurseries, which sell to the general public, wholesale nurseries, which sell only to businesses such as other nurseries and, which supply

the needs of institutions or private estates. Some of them specialize in one phase of the process: propagation, growing out, or retail sale; or in one type of plant: e.g., groundcovers, shade plants, or rock garden plants. Some produce bulk stock, whether seedlings or grafted, of particular varieties for purposes such as fruit trees. Guidance on Sitafruit and Pomegranate Cultivation and Commodity Sale of Sitafruit and Pomegranate in Madhya Pradesh Jabalpur Indore, Surat Ahmedabad Markets in Gujarat etc.

The lecture is delivered by the Dr. Santosh Kute, Chairman BoS Economics Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati, his was Speaking on the subject of challenges facing Indian agriculture, Santosh Kute said that while agriculture is progressing due to changing technology in the agricultural sector, there has been unaccountable monsoon rains. Due to erratic timing of rains and sometimes too much and sometimes too little rainfall, there has been a huge difference in farm income. In his lecture, he highlighted the lost prices of agricultural commodities due to natural crisis in agriculture along with changing government policy and export ban for commodities which are in global demand due to import of large quantities of Agriculture products.

2.30-4.00

Eight Lecture Delivered by Dr. Vanita Pochhi Head department of Botany. His topic was Tissue Culture Plants. Guidance on production and marketing of tissue culture plants in Indian agriculture and agro-based industries. He further said that tissue culture plants are very beneficial and useful in plant science in terms of plant

growth and development and in terms of increasing production in fruit crops. At Sinkhedaraja in Buldhana district Mr. Vayal developed a tissue culture plant nursery and provided employment to 500 women in the rural areas. Besides, they are producing and selling tissue culture plants and exporting them. He gave the information to the students that there will be economic development.

Day 5: Tuesday

Lecture 9th :

The ninth lecture is delivered by the Shri. Vijay Ambhore, Goat Sheep Breeding Center, Sipora. Ta. Jafrabad Dist. Jalna. He explained detailed about the Goat form, Goats are among the main meat-producing animals in India, whose meat (chevon) is one of the choicest meats and has huge domestic demand. Due to its good economic prospects, goat rearing under intensive and semi-intensive system for commercial production has been gaining momentum for the past couple of years. High demand for goat and its products with potential of good economic returns have been deriving many progressive farmers, businessmen, professionals, ex-servicemen and educated youths to take up the goat enterprise on a commercial scale. The emerging favorable market conditions and easy accessibility to improved goat technologies are also catching the attention of entrepreneurs. A number of commercial goat farms have been established in different regions of the country.

The tenth lecture is delivered by Dr. Ganesh Malte Head Marathi Department on Farmers suicide problem in vidharabha region and state Government policy. He explained details in the Maharashtra government's measures to prevent farmer suicides and their implementation are being successfully implemented, the suicides of farmers are increasing day by day due to the barrenness of agriculture. As the main reason in the suicide affected areas is financial scarcity, the farmers should adopt agricultural experiments in order to increase the income of the farmers. If farmers start milk production, even if the farmer has one cow or one buffalo, if he is engaged in that work all day long, he will not think of suicide in his mind. to farmers

Day 6: Wednesday

Lecture 11th :

The tenth lecture is delivered by Shri Pandharinath Gunjkar propirter Yashawant Agrivutural Engineering Undri Dist. Buldana. he has share is experience in Pandharinath Gunjkar started agricultural engineering manufacturing in a small village of Undari. Initially, he started manufacturing new modified agricultural

implements like bullock carts, agricultural implements, bullock cart wheels, steel tank for cow dung gas, tractor trolleys, cultivators, sowing machines, etc. from his factory. With inspiration, more than ten factories were set up in Undri area and hundreds of people got employment. Due to his work in agricultural engineering, Panjabrao Deshmukh Agricultural University appointed him as a member of the Senate and the Department of Agricultural Engineering takes his guidance from time to time. In his lecture, he informed the students about agricultural engineering production in agriculture, besides, there are huge opportunities for farmers in seed processing industries.
